The Baltic Coastal Hiking Route

(Jūrtaka (LV), Ranniku matkarada (EST), 1419 km, E9) follows the Baltic Sea coastline, while **The Baltic Forest Trail** (Mežtaka (LV), Metsa matkarada (EST), 2141 km, E11) runs through forests from Poland to Estonia.

Both trails cross Latvia, Estonia, and Lithuania, offering diverse landscapes and nature experiences.







Located in Kuldīga, Ventas Rumba spans 249 meters, making it Europe's widest waterfall.

The town of Kuldīga's Old Town is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the Forest Trail (Mežtaka), a long-distance hiking route, passes through this historic area, making it a key destination for nature and culture tourism.

Sigulda, a city in Gauja National Park, is known for the Gauja River Valley, Gutman's Cave, and an bobsleigh track. The Forest Trail passes through, making it one of the key hiking spots. In winter, it offers several ski hills.



#5 **SIGULDA - LĪGATNE**



FORESTS

This part of the Forest Trail and the Gauia National Park is characterised by a gradual transition from diverse, deciduous forests (ash, grey alder, oak, birch, linden) to coniferous stands. A restored park-like forest landscape has been developed at Klaukas bight, where Vējupīte enters Gauja. Nowadays, when meadows and pastures are no longer used for grazing and hav gathering. many bights of the Gauja River overgrow, even though there used to be lush meadows here in early 20th century. The area also featured many large, solitary trees that used to be home to more than 300 species of mosses, lichens, invertebrates, birds and mammals.

SIGULDA - LĪGATNE, 24 km In the heart of Gauja National Park

After passing through Sigulda, the Forest Trail follows the River Vējupīte to Mound Paradīzes, where a steep staircase leads down into the ancient valley of Gauja River and the ravine of River Vējupīte. It continues to wind down smaller paths through meadows, crossing small rivers whose banks reveal sandstone outcrops. The last six kilometres of this section follow a smaller path down Līgatne Nature Trails. As it draws closer to Līgatne, the Forest Trail moves up the hills of Gauja valley, before descending back down into the deep ravine of Līgatne River, where the village of the former Līgatne Paper Mill is located.




